- ✓ Moisturizer, Cream, Deodorants, Perfumes, talcum powder.
- ✓ Each boarder must bring a sitting stool from home (plastic or steel) with their Boarding Number marked on it.
- ✓ 1 Navy blue Blazer [Single Breast; 3 Buttons with a Slit at the back & Green and Gold braid.] [Compulsory For Students Of Classes 9 & 10. OPTIONAL for Classes 6 to 8].
- ✓ Keypad phones without internet facilities are permitted. Top up/Recharge needs to be done for the year.

Phone Call Home

Boarders are allowed to call their parents every Sunday. Please be available to receive your ward's phone call at the given time on Sundays. Tuck (Snacks bought from home)

- Boarders are allowed to access the tuck room only twice a week.
- Parents/Guardian are requested to provide your ward only healthy snacks.
- Provide your ward with snacks with longer shelf life, so that it won't get spoiled.
- Parents are requested to limit the tuck sent by courier. (Tuck/other parcels to delivered on the last Sunday of the month)

Pocket Money

Parents are to deposit Rs. 10000/- (Ten Thousand) in the school pocket money account in the beginning of the year.

Pocket money will be used for following purpose

- Weekly pocket money of Rs. 100/- coupons will be given to your son. This money can be used by him to buy snacks from the school canteen or to buy basic stationery.
- Boarders must not have coupons worth more than Rs. 200/-. Any extra coupons found will be confiscated and not reimbursed.
- Boarders are given Rs. 250/- each for every town walk. Usually, there are 3 to 4 town walks in an academic year.
- Hobbies and project expenses incurred by your ward will be deducted from pocket money. (This is done only on prior permission from parents)
- Birthday celebration expenses (Sweets & pastries) maximum of Rs. 750/- for students of classes 3 to 9 and Rs. 1000/- for class 10 students.
- For any other extra expenses incurred by your ward during the academic year. (This is done only on prior permission from parents)

The balance pocket money will be refunded back to the parents or will be carried forward to the next academic year. Please maintain sufficient balance in your ward's pocket money account.
